

Call for Participation

The Workshop *Open development of sustainable educational technologies (Nuts& Bolts @ DELFI 2022)* as part of the DELFI 2022 conference is open for **submissions in the field of technological decision-making processes in TEL research**.

The workshop targets researchers and practitioners who are interested in the development of TEL artefacts, like learning analytics dashboard, serious games, educational simulations or applications for the various technologies in the field of education. We take a broad perspective on this topic and welcome submissions from different fields. The workshop provides a chance to showcase the underlying technology stack or the implemented toolchain of a research process, either in a project or as part of the Ph.D. effort. Further, the workshop offers a forum to discuss tools and processes currently at the verge of important technological decisions with fellow researchers.

We offer two types of submissions:

Workshop paper and extended abstracts (talks). Both include, but are not limited to

- a retrospective on research processes in a mature state, but also early concepts and work in progress submissions are explicitly welcomed
- documentations of the implementation and decision-making process
- help for junior researchers in the discovery and planning phase
- the technical challenges of OER
- presentations of current research efforts from a technological perspective

To give credit to the technical nature of this workshop, it is possible to submit supplementary materials along with any contribution in both tracks. The discussions during the workshop should base on the most recent state possible, thus the supplement materials can be submitted until two weeks prior to the workshop and will be made available to registered participants at latest 72h before the workshop begins. This material can include, but is not limited to, illustrations like decision trees and structure charts, posters, videos or code snippets. The supplementary materials are not counted towards the page limit of the contributions.

Accepted workshop papers will be published without supplementary materials in the joint workshop proceedings of the DELFI conference.
